

CAT- treatment agreement

By signing this document, therapist and client acknowledge that:

- The client is going to be treated by the therapist and has been informed of the rates requested by this therapist.
- The client is aware of and gives permission for the treatment option(s) chosen together and proposed by the therapist and is aware of and gives permission for the treatment plan drawn up by the therapist (taking into account that a treatment plan is an estimate).
- The therapist undertakes to refer the client to a fellow therapist or doctor if the treatment is not compensable or cannot be continued due to illness, death or a condition.
- Termination of treatment can occur at any time with simultaneous consent.
- Termination of treatment can occur unilaterally by the client if the client no longer appreciates the treatment or considers it necessary.
- If the treatment is terminated by the client and this happens against the advice of the therapist; the client does this at his/her own risk and prepares to sign a statement whereby the client terminates the treatment without the therapist's approval.
- The treatment by the therapist can be terminated unilaterally if he/she cannot reasonably be expected to continue the treatment.
- The client is aware of the complaints procedure and can contact the state-recognized Wkkgz disputes body conducted by the therapist for complaints, see the website of the relevant disputes body below:

- between the client and therapist; cash, by pin per consultation etc. The client will receive an invoice (immediately handed over or afterwards by post or e-mail for example) from the therapist as soon as he/she has confirmation that the payment has been completed.
- The client is aware of the fact that the therapist keeps a client file.
- The therapeutic file is identical to the AVG and the privacy statement; CAT treatment agreement

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as can be found on the website: www.hiddendivine.nl before reaching 18 years: 18 years after the year of signing, the client file must be kept for at least 20 years.

- The client is aware of the colleague therapist with whom the therapist has concluded a substitution and transfer agreement. The colleague therapist can subordinate the practice in the event of the therapist's absence or take over in the event of the practice closing.

Check additional questions that apply if necessary:

The client has no objection to sharing the client file when the practice is separated by the colleague therapist.

The client has no objection to transferring the client file when the practice is taken over by the colleague therapist.
